Students will analyze and compare the political strategy and aims of the EU towards eastern and southern neighbours; will study the political initiatives and financial contribution of the EU to support democratization processes in the EU's neighbourhood, to fight against poverty, to solve the sociopolitical problems.

To provide with the knowledge and abilities to recognize, analyze and compare the forms and instruments of the EU support towards developing countries in the European neighbourhood.

Study (teaching and learning) methods

Lecturing methods: description of information and knowledge in using various technologies: Power

Point, commenting videos; practical event characterization and analysis; interactive discussions; oral consultations and by university intranet system; students' work in groups during lectures and seminars.
