Short course description:	The purpose of this course is to introduce the main curriculum theories and principles of curriculum design. The course is taught by 3 professors, who teach in a sequence. The content of this course is based on different UNESCO IBE case studies of curriculum development, assessment and implementation in different countries of the world and offers a global perspective on curriculum development.
Course content:	The course consists of three major parts: (1) curriculum design frameworks and matrixes, (2) curriculum evaluation and student assessment, (3) curriculum implementation and piloting.
Grading and evaluating student work in class and/or at the final exam:	The grade of the course is accumulated through 11 different individual and group assignments that are graded from 5% to 20% each to form the 100% of the final mark.
