Short course description:	Jazz ensemble is a performing art (specialization – jazz performer) program subject which is meant to develop the special (professional) skills of a performer. The content of the studies consists of singing/playing in an ensemble, skill formation, musical text performance by heart and artistic skill development. During the studies, group work experience is gained, the personality of an artist-creator is developed. This is the first level of a subject that takes up seven semesters, during which the skills of singing/playing in a vocal or instrumental ensemble are developed, simple jazz standard arrangements are learnt.

Jazz standards (for example: <i>All of me, Autumn leaves, Bye bye blackbird, Basin street blues, C jam blues, Quiet nights of quiet stars, Don't get around much anymore, It don't mean a thing, Hello, Doly, Mack the knife, Route 66, Summertime</i> ).
