Short course description:	<p>The course aims to further develop the basic grammar skills and communication models so that students acquire relative fluency in daily life conversation. The main grammatical topics include, tense conjunctions and introduction of honorific expressions. The students will learn how to express permissions and prohibitions, as well as define changes, and use passive verbs.</p>
Course content:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Making a bank account: expressing obligation, intention, asking for permission; participial modifiers.• Daily life & hobbies: expressing action sequences, expressing progressive action, expressing simultaneous actions.• Food & health: expressing assumptions, explain background/contrast situation, indicating past experiences.• Weather & vacation: indicating reason, indicating change from the past, indicating plan of action, indicating a choice between two or more options.• Accommodation & socializing: expressing cause/reason (colloquial form), passive verbs, expressing speaker's desire or will.
