CONTEST FOR TEACHING AND TRAINING VISITS UNDER ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME FOR PARTNER COUNTRIES¹ (non-EU/EEA) DURING SPRING AND AUTUMN SEMESTERS OF 2025

International Cooperation Department invites all VMU academic and non-academic staff members to participate in the contest for *Erasmus+* teaching and training visits in Partner countries.

All VMU staff members who wish to participate in the contest are welcome to [submit the application on the Mobility Online system](#) **until November 29, 2024**. Please follow [this link](#) to find the instructions on how to fill out the application. Candidates commit to coordinate the application with the head of the department.

Priority will be given to teaching visits.

Results of the competition will be announced on December 18.

Note:

! When applying, it is necessary to specify the semester when you plan to go on the study/teaching visit. After confirmation of application the visit cannot be moved to another semester;

! VMU staff members can submit 1 application where they are allowed to choose up to 2 countries / universities (list by priority) for teaching or training visit. If there are more than 1 application, they will be rejected;

! VMU staff members do not need to contact Partner universities during the contest, it will be made after the selection results.

Application eligibility criteria for teaching visits:

- selected institution is a VMU partner institution and is announced in the call;
- not less than 8 teaching hours;
- the objectives of the visit, the added value, the topics of the lectures/seminars and the expected outcomes are explained in the application;
- commitment to coordinate the application with the head of the department.

The content of the application shall be evaluated on a 9-point scale according to the criterion “Added value for the participant, the unit and the University”. Added value for the participant, the unit and the University will be evaluated separately, with a maximum of 3 points given to each criterion, where 1 is weakly justified, 2 is incompletely justified, 3 is an excellent description of the added value.

Additional points shall be awarded for:

- candidates who teach at VMU in English or another foreign language (1 point);
- visits where the planned teaching time exceeds the minimum Erasmus+ requirements, i.e., more than 8 hours (1 point);

- c. candidates participating for the first time in the Erasmus+ teaching visits programme (third countries not associated to the Programme) (1 point);
- d. candidates with fewer opportunities (1 point).

Application eligibility criteria for training visits:

- a. selected institution is a VMU partner institution (announced in the call for proposals);
- b. the objectives of the visit, the added value, the topics of the lectures/seminars and the expected outcomes explained in the application;
- c. the aim of the visit includes the professional development of the staff member through study/exchange of experience activities;
- d. the information provided in the Application shall not be duplicative/identical to the information provided in the Application of another candidate participating in the same competition;
- e. Commitment to coordinate the application with the head of the department.

The content of the application shall be evaluated on a 9-point scale according to the criterion “Added value for the participant, the unit and the University”. Added value for the participant, the unit and the University will be evaluated separately, with a maximum of 3 points given to each criterion, where 1 is weakly justified, 2 is incompletely justified, 3 is an excellent description of the added value.

Additional points shall be awarded for:

- a. candidates participating for the first time in the Erasmus+ study visits programme (third countries not associated to the Programme) (1 point);
- b. candidates with no academic workload (1 point);
- c. candidates with more than 2 years’ continuous service at VMU (1 point);
- d. candidates with fewer opportunities (1 point).

Selected participants will receive (depending on the project financing):

Grant	180,00-190,00 Eur per day
Grant to cover travel costs (the amount depends on the distance between VMU (Kaunas city) and place of receiving HEI (city) ²	100-499 km – 180,00 -211,00 EUR; 500-1999 km – 275,00-309,00 EUR; 2000-2999 km – 360,00-395,00 EUR; 3000-3999 km – 530,00-580,00 EUR; 4000-7999 km – 820,00-1188,00 EUR; More than 8000 km – 1500,00-1735,00 EUR
