Short course description:	During the semester students will be introduced to new grammatical forms of comparison, potentiality, wish, "must". Students will master the usage of short (plain, formal) verb and adjective constructions in present and past tenses, as well as basic conjunctions. After finishing this course, students will be able to speak, understand and write simple sentences, needed in Korean daily communication.
Course content:	 Vacation – expressing wishes & contradictions, connecting actions and sentences. Home shopping – expressing requests and negative commands, shopping expressions, numerals. Invitations – expressing reason & conditions, means of transport, expressing a sequence of action. Trips – asking for opinion, expressing suggestions & intentions, asking about experiences, and indicating methods or degrees. Hobbies – expressions of comparison, expressing the ability of perform an action or not, complex verbs, participial modifiers.
