Short course description:	This course aims to teach new vocabulary, indirect speech and the informal <i>banmal</i> forms that are necessary for colloquial communication. The students will learn to express themselves on cultural and social topics by using the upper beginner level grammar models, to apply formal Korean language expressions in writing and to use special determined expressions (greetings, apologies, enquiries, etc.)
Course content:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Active lifestyle & job interviews: expressing proposals, expressing reason or a fact, expressing contrast, descriptive constructions.• Shopping & dating: indicating tendency, asking for confirmation, describing a plan or decision.• Directions & invitations: expressing a sequence of complete/incomplete actions, showing purpose, expressing choices.• Travelling & Competition: expressing direction, indirect speech.• Natural disasters & working part-time: indicating reason/cause, informal language (plain forms), giving reason/new information.
