This COREnet summer school aims to provide early career researchers (PhDs, postdocs and researchers up to 40 years old) with the opportunity to deepen their understanding of the migration and religious diversity field and highlight research and practice - based knowledge from international trainers in order to present best practice to international trainees and to increase the knowledge in the field as well as to learn how to apply it in preparation of practice-oriented research.

The COREnet summer school will aim at studying theories, methods and practical issues arising from the research into migration and religious diversity. During the COREnet summer school its participants will be working on their individual practice-oriented research project.

Final evaluation of the participants will be provided by schoolteachers after they submit the critical reflection of their own research project from the perspective of practice and ethics relevance.

Participants of the training school will receive a certificate of attendance 3 ECTS worth.

Who can attend?

- PhD students and postdocs in the area of the study of religion and migration.
- Young Researchers and Innovators (YRI) < 40 years old starting their research activities in the field of religion and migration.
