

ATTENTION TO ALL VMU STUDENTS ! COMPETITION For Short-Term Courses Abroad

Students are invited to participate in a competition for short-term courses abroad **IN 2023 m.** with VMU Mobility scholarship.

VMU FULL-TIME DEGREE STUDENTS ARE WELCOME:

- 1. Check the offers of short-term courses and summer / winter schools abroad:
 - Offers from VMU partners abroad
 - <u>StudyPortals Short Courses</u>
 - Summer Schools in Europe
- 2. **Choose** the best options of fee-based courses from the provided lists or find other courses which offer the credits. The period of the courses up to 3 months.
- 3. Make sure that:
 - the courses are fee-based,
 - o the courses do not overlap your study period at VMU,
 - you have enough time for documentation (check the application deadline of the hosting institution).
- 4. Submit the <u>online application form</u> (Outgoing-Application for Short-Term Courses and Summer/Winter Schools) by proving your motivation.

Selection criteria:

- All VMU full-time degree students can participate in the competition. Exception applies for the final semester students.
- Motivation.
- Academic results of studies or research during the last two semesters (for VMU Mobility scholarship GPA should be not lower than 8.0).
- Good knowledge of the language in which courses will be taught.
- Additional academic, professional or social activities in Lithuania or abroad.

Applications will be accepted <u>before the last day of each month</u>. The final results of the competition will be announced on the 15th day of the next month on the VMU website. Each student will also be informed personally by e-mail.

Selected students will receive the VMU Mobility scholarship. Scholarships:

On-site fee-based short-term courses and summer/winter schools which offer credits for attendees.	600 Eur
Online fee-based short-term courses and summer/winter schools which offer credits for attendees.	Up to 600 Eur (depending on the price of the course)
