

Vytautas Magnus University (VMU) invites Ukrainian citizens to choose bachelor's and master's degree study programmes with a possibility to receive up to 100 % tuition fee waiver for the entire study period and arrive to study in Kaunas.

In 2020, VMU established a support fund dedicated to students who suffered from repression by the Belarusian government. Now, this fund also support students who suffered from Russia's war in Ukraine. Since the beginning of the war, VMU accepted over 250 students from Ukraine.

UKRAINIAN CITIZENS, RESIDING IN UKRAINE AND OTHER COUNTRIES, ARE OFFERED:

- Bachelor's and Master's degree study programmes (in English). List of study programmes can be accessed <u>here</u>
- Bachelor's degree study programme <u>Accounting and Finance</u> (1st year is taught in Russian, from the 2nd year the language of instruction is English)
- VMU tuition fee waiver up to 100 % for the entire study period depending on the study results
- <u>Lithuanian state scholarships</u> for full-time Master's degree: monthly scholarship and a grant covering the study cost (60 grants for Ukrainian citizens)
- Possibility to be accommodated at VMU dormitory free of charge depending on dormitory availability and number of admitted students
