





# ATTENTION TO ALL VMU STUDENTS ! COMPETITION FOR

Short-Term Courses Abroad!

Students are invited to participate in a competition for short-term courses abroad with a <u>VMU Mobility scholarship</u>.

## VMU FULL-TIME DEGREE STUDENTS ARE WELCOME:

- 1. Check the offers of short-term courses and summer / winter schools abroad:
  - o Offers from VMU partners abroad
  - <u>StudyPortals Short Courses</u>
  - o <u>Summer Schools in Europe</u>
- 2. Choose the best options of fee-based courses from the provided lists or find other short term (<u>up to 3 months</u>) courses that offer the credits.
- 3. Make sure that:
  - o courses provide **credits**,
  - o courses are **fee-based**,
  - o courses do not overlap your study period at VMU,
  - you have enough time for documentation (check the application deadline of the hosting institution).
- 4. Submit the <u>online application form</u> (Outgoing-Application for Short-Term Courses and Summer/Winter Schools) by proving your motivation.

### Selection criteria:

- All VMU full-time degree students can participate in the competition. <u>Exception applies for the final semester</u> <u>students and BA first semester students.</u>
- Motivation.
- Academic results of studies or research during the last two semesters (GPA should be not lower than 8.0).
- Good **knowledge of the language** in which courses will be taught (not lower than B2 level).
- Additional academic, professional, or social activities in Lithuania or abroad.

Applications will be accepted by the 15<sup>th</sup> day of each month. The results of the competition will be announced on the last day of each month on the VMU website. Each student will also be informed personally via e-mail.

#### Selected students will receive the VMU Mobility scholarship. Scholarships:

On-site fee-based short-term courses and summer/winter schools that offer credits for attendees.	600 Eur
Online fee-based short-term courses and summer/winter schools that offer credits for attendees.	Up to 600 Eur (depending on the price of the course)
