Vytautas Magnus University Alumni Survey Results: Studies from the Alumni Perspective

June – July 2023







The survey of alumni was conducted in June and July 2023.

The goal was to determine the opinion of Vytautas Magnus University (further – University, VMU) alumni in 2022 about studies and their preparation for professional activities.

Respondents: VMU students who had studied in bachelor, master, integrated and professional study programmes and were surveyed one year after graduation.

The respondents' answers about their studies are presented below.

151 alumni (8,19% of VMU alumni) completed the survey – 70 of bachelor, 60 master, 11 integrated and 10 professional studies alumni.



More extensive internship opportunities to strengthen the knowledge acquired in the study programme.


Better sequence of specialised study courses, updated study equipment that better meets the needs of the modern professional world.
