

### **HOW TO REACH KAUNAS...**

... from Vilnius airport

#### Step 1

Vilnius airport is just a bit more than 6 kilometers away from Vilnius train or bus stations. You can reach them using both public transport or a taxi as well as a world-wide popular Uber or Bolt.

# **VILNIUS - KAUNAS**

#### Step 2

From Vilnius bus or tran stations there are three options to reach Kaunas city, either by bus or train. Bus and train stations are near each other, so you can choose whichever is more convenient for you.

# FROM KAUNAS AIRPORT TO KAUNAS CENTRE

#### Option 1

Take a public bus No. 29G (destination: Geležinkelio stotis) to reach Kaunas city centre. You can find the bus routes, timetables here.

We advise you to download and use the mobile app "Žiogas" (for <u>Android</u> or <u>iOS</u>) for purchasing tickets for the public transport in Kaunas.

#### Option 2

To reach Kaunas city centre you can use Bolt app service for <u>Android</u> or <u>iOS</u> (taxi), regular taxi or CityBee car sharing service (for <u>Android</u> or <u>iOS</u>), which are all available at the <u>Kaunas Airport</u>.

# FROM KAUNAS CENTRE TO VMU ACADEMY CAMPUS

#### Option 1

Take a public bus No. 29G (destination: Geležinkelio stotis) to reach Kaunas city centre. To reach VMU Academy campus, after getting off from 29G bus stop (destination: Geležinkelio stotis) at the bus terminal stop, you need to take a bus No. 18 from the bus stop on the other side of the street. Please note bus No. 18 always has VMU Academy campus as its final destination. You can find the bus routes, timetables here.

We advise you to download and use the mobile app "Žiogas" (for <u>Android</u> or <u>iOS</u>) for purchasing tickets for the public transport in Kaunas.

#### **Option 2**

To reach VMU Academy campus you can use Bolt app service (taxi) for <u>Android</u> or <u>iOS</u>, regular taxi (~15 eur) or CityBee car sharing service (for <u>Android</u> or <u>iOS</u>), which are all available at the Kaunas Airport.

#### **Buses**

The internal city public transport includes buses and trolleybuses. Trolleybuses and buses run from 4.30 a.m. until 10.30 p.m.

We advise you to download and use the mobile app "Žiogas" (for <u>Android</u> or <u>iOS</u>) for purchasing tickets for the public transport in Kaunas. Check more information <u>here!</u>





#### **Bicycle**

Cycling conditions have been improving in Kaunas for a few years now. You can either bring your bike or rent one to explore Kaunas. Pricing is 0.50 Eur / 30 min and after using it you can leave it on any CityBee bike rack in Kaunas.

It is very convenient if you want to see our beautiful city and enjoy your visit to Kaunas. Read about routes and tips <u>here!</u>





#### **Scooters**

Currently, the most popular way in Lithuania to reach any destination at low cost. It is very convenient because, after the ride, you can leave it almost anywhere in the city centre.

To start a ride, you only need to download the <u>Bolt app</u>, which will be very useful to take a taxi or take a ride with a scooter. Pricing of service variates between 0.50- 1.00 Eur / h.





#### **Taxi**

Taxi prices are different, depending on the time and place at which the taxi is ordered. The average price for one kilometer by taxi is 0.70 Eur.

We recommend using <u>Bolt app</u> if possible, so that you would be able to see a precise price of upcoming trip.



# **ACCOMMODATION**

#### Hotel "Kaunas"

The average cost for room per night: ~70 eur

#### Moxy Kaunas Center

The average cost for room per night: ~60 eur

#### **Best Baltic**

The average cost for room per night: ~50 eur

More accommodation options can be found on <u>Airbnb</u> or <u>Booking</u>.

It is recommended to choose the accommodation in the city centre (near Laisvės alėja).

#### **Introduction**

Located in the confluence of the Nemunas and the Neris rivers, Kaunas is one of the major cities of Lithuania.

It could be described as a city that never accepted its role as the second city in the country. It is not only a city of old traditions, but also a large centre of business and industry.

During the interwar period, Kaunas was the "temporary capital" of Lithuania and developed into a modern, vibrant and dynamic cultural centre of the country.

With almost three hundred thousand inhabitants it can also lay claim to be a city of young people with over 35,000 students (the largest number in Lithuania) studying at one of the seven universities here.




# **SAFETY**



Lithuania is a member of the EU and Schengen Area. Citizens of the EU countries and 30 other states, including Australia, Canada, the UK, the USA, New Zealand, Japan, South Korea, Malaysia etc., can stay in the Schengen Area for a period of 90 days without a special visa.
