Ranked among the top 3% of universities in the world (QS World University Rankings), VMU is the most comprehensive higher education institution in Lithuania, with a rich history, cherishing and continuing its long tradition, playing a special role not only in Lithuania, but also in the intellectual and cultural space of the entire Baltic region and Europe.

The University community is united by Artes liberales, i.e. the idea of a classical liberal arts university, by warm and sincere communication based on dialogue rather than hierarchy, and by the liberal humanist spirit that constantly accompanies and reinforces it.

With the merger of three universities (Vytautas Magnus University, Lithuanian University of Educational Sciences and Aleksandras Stulginskis University) in 2019, VMU became the most comprehensive university in the country, further strengthening its scientific and interdisciplinary potential.

Civic-minded and responsible

VMU has a significant impact on social development at the national and international levels, through analysis of geopolitical processes, development of democracy and civic-mindedness as well as development cooperation activities, education policy-making and implementation, socially responsible and inclusive society-building, community development and volunteering.

On 18 December 2017, the Andrei Sakharov Research Centre for Democratic Development at Vytautas Magnus University opened its doors, focusing on human and civil rights issues and academic research on Central and Eastern Europe. It will soon be five years since Vytautas Magnus University, together with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Lithuania, the Coalition of Human Rights Organisations (Lithuania), the Office of the Equal Opportunities Ombudsperson, the Lithuanian Disability Forum, the Seimas of the Republic of Lithuania, the Seimas Ombudspersons' Office, and the Office of

the Ombudsperson for Child's Rights, has organised the National Forum on Human Rights. The Forum, which has become an annual tradition, invites the public to discuss the situation of human rights in Lithuania and ways to ensure that our country is a good place to live for people of all nationalities, religions, genders, social statuses, beliefs and opinions. In June 2022, the Centre of Ukraine at VMU Education Academy, initiated by the First Lady of Lithuania, Diana Nausėdienė, and the First Lady of Ukraine, Olena Zelenska, was established for the Ukrainian community fleeing the war. The Centre aims to create a welcoming environment for Ukrainians and provide language training as well as offer psychological support. The activities of the Centre of Ukraine are supported by a team of volunteers from VMU staff and a constantly expanding network of supporters.

VMU researchers and teachers attain the highest academic achievements, publishing articles in distinguished international journals. They also actively participate in calls for the EU research and innovation programmes Horizon 2020 and Horizon Europe and are successfully involved in research project consortia. 



FIRST STEPS FOR THE NEWLY EMPLOYED

1. APPLICATION.

Complete the hiring-application form along with the supporting documents and submit them to the Human Resources Department.



2. CONTRACT.

Sign the employment contract.

3. VMU ACCOUNT.*

Log in to VMU IT systems and create a password for your VMU account.

- Login name firstname.lastname.
- Password: Create a new one at https://pagalba.vdu.lt (use the personal email address at which you received the first email).
- VMU email address is firstname. lastname@vdu.lt.



4. STAFF MEMBER IDENTIFICATION CARD.

A staff member applies for a staff member identification card and access rights in the Document Management System (hereinafter referred to as the DMS) by logging in to his/her IT account. If the staff member works holds more than one position, the staff member selects a position in the DMS and applies through that position. The application is submitted only by the staff member himself/herself.

5. DOCUMENTS.

STAFF MEMBER IDENTIFICATION CARD.

Important:

- when applying for a staff member identification card, attach a good-quality photograph meeting the general requirements for identity documents. If necessary, a photographer can be arranged by contacting the Communication Unit of the Marketing and Communication Department at komunikacija@vdu.lt,
- if the staff member identification card is urgently needed, a temporary card will be issued upon request.

Note. If the staff member is a teacher, all lecture halls and computer classrooms are automatically included in the access rights of the staff member identification card.

Access rights to other facilities (premises, locations) are granted by the staff member's supervisor. The supervisor contacts the IT Centre to request that access rights be assigned to a specific staff member. The request must specify the room(s) in a particular building.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

VMU SYSTEMS

All questions related to IT systems are processed only when coming from an authenticated user, i.e. the question must be sent from VMU Outlook mailbox, except questions related to the creation of a new password and login to the Outlook mailbox.

Unable to create a password at <u>pagalba.vdu.lt</u>.

- You entered the wrong details when creating a new password:
 - » enter a login name without Lithuanian letters, e.g. vardune.pavardaite-pavardiene;
 - » enter your personal email address that you provided when you started working at the University, e.g. vakaras@gmail.com.
- If you are thinking of creating your password before the first working day wait until the first working day.
- You did not provide your personal email address to the Human Resources Department (HRD) with your other documents when you were applying. Contact HRD and submit your personal email address.
- There is a delay in formalising your employment contract contact HRD.

I can't log in to Outlook even though I have successfully created a password.

Create a new password again and when logging in to Outlook, enter the login name together with the institution's domain, which is @vdu.lt – the same for all users, e.g. firstname.lastname@vdu.lt.

The microphone or sound doesn't work when you connect to Microsoft Teams. Make a test call in Teams. Information on how to do it HERE



I can't log in to the Teacher portal, although I can log in to Outlook.

Contact the Study Department to be granted Teacher status.

I can't log in to the StudIS system for submitting work trip applications, although I can log in to Outlook.

Inform us at it@vdu.lt.

I can't log in to the Document Management System (DMS), although I can log in to Outlook.

The earliest you can connect to the DMS is the second working day after the start of your employment.

Unable to connect to the Eduroam wireless network.

Enter your username in the login field in the format firstname.lastname@vdu.lt and enter your Outlook password in the password field.





PRINTING

Unable to register the card to the printer.

Log in to the multi-function printer with your username (firstname.lastname) and password. On the printer screen, press the button "Card registration". Press the card against the reader and hold it for a few seconds until you hear an audio signal. If this does not work, call the building's ITC specialist or complete a request form at https://itpagalba.vdu.lt

When I log in to the printer, it asks me to pay, although I am an employee.

I do not receive a scanned document in my email.

Scan in batches, with fewer sheets in each batch. If this does not work, contact the building's ITC specialist or complete a request form at https://itpagalba.vdu.lt
