

Equal opportunities at university (I)

- VMU strives to create a **safe, healthy, inclusive and respectful environment** for all members of the community
- Human rights are guaranteed: **dignity, non-discrimination, equal opportunities** regardless of:
 - gender, age, sexual orientation

 - disability, socio-economic or marital status

Equal opportunities at the university (II)

- Students undertake to comply with the **Code of Ethics** by signing the contract
- **Ethical relations at the university:** respect, collegiality, tolerance, fair competition
- **The Ethics Commission** examines violations
- The following are considered to be violations:
 - sexual harassment
 - mobbing
 - discrimination
 - other unethical behaviour or omissions

 - Confidentiality guaranteed
- **Prevention of sexual harassment**
 - It is important how the situation is viewed by the person who is experiencing the behavior
 - Difference between flirting and harassment:
 - Flirting → pleasant for both parties
 - Harassment → unwanted, pleasing only to one side
